January 17, 2001,

the Division of Forestry sold 78 trees from Yellowwood State Forest to a private timber company. In response, the Yellowwood Tree Huggers launched a treesit in the sale area that would last for more than eight months. This treesit, in what came to be known as the Prometheus Tree, was the first of its kind in the Midwest. As a result of this direct action and sustained public pressure, the state eventually cancelled

plans to log this area, marking a rare victory for eco-defense in Indiana.
